



Children are indirect recipients as they are the sons of the women we care for. We offer them assistance and support as victims of violence suffered by their mothers or directly.

For this reason we have provided figures as educators who accompany them on the path to exit from violence as children of the mothers we follow and, in the semi-autonomy house we have foreseen the possibility of hosting them with their mothers.

Anyhow the Battiti project is based on a children's rights approach.

Children have human rights - like adults - which are very similar, but children need extra protection because of their vulnerability.

Our approach is based on:

- non-discrimination
- devotion to the best interests of the child
- the right to life, survival and development
- and respect for the views of the child

Our safe policy is committed to child safety and wellbeing, taking child participation seriously, involving families, respecting equity and diversity and ensuring that staff are suitable and supported.

Child protection policy will create a child-safe organisation. We protect children (from abuse and exploitation by staff), staff (by providing guidance and laying out a just process for handling allegations) and the organisation (from damage to its reputation).
